Frequently asked questions:

Q: How many members does the Verona Rescue Squad have?

A: We currently have over 50 full and associate members.

Q: How many members comprise a crew when answering calls?

A: We need a minimum of 2 adult members, one being a certified EMT and the other a certified driver. Under ideal situations, we have 4 person crews answering calls.

Q: How many "ideal situations" currently exist?

A: Most nights and all days do not have enough assigned members to comprise a full crew of 4.

Q: I have no training in first aid. How can I possibly help?

A: Most members join with no formal training. Once you become a member, you can help on calls with lifting and carrying, filling out the patient forms, obtaining patient vital signs and many other tasks that do not need formal training.

Q: What about training?

A: All training is provided by us and our partner organizations. A personalized training schedule will be created for you that will include CPR and Emergency Medical Responder (advanced first aid) or EMT (emergency medical technician).

Q: What will membership cost me?

A: There is no out of pocket expense. All training, uniforms and equipment will be paid for by the Verona Rescue Squad.

Mission Statement: "The mission of the Verona Rescue Squad is to maintain an ambulance and rescue service free of charge to the citizens and residents of the Township of Verona and to cooperate with the police department, fire department, other town agencies and neighboring squads."

The Verona Rescue Squad is not a paid town service but rather a volunteer organization that provides free services to the town, 24 hours a day, every day of the year!

We are everyday people from all over our town; your friends, neighbors, co-parishioners and schoolmates. We are from all kinds of backgrounds, all kinds of jobs and all kinds of interests. We range in age from 16 to over 70. In other words, we are just like you and need people like you to join our membership.

The one thing that we all have in common is the desire to assist our fellow neighbors when needed. It takes a little training and a certain commitment of time, but the rewards are more than words can express.

The Verona Rescue Squad operates 3 ambulances, 1 heavy rescue vehicle and 1 command vehicle.

We have a scheduled volunteer crew assigned to every night of the week from 6:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

The day hours are covered by our volunteer members who are available during the day. While daytime membership is always needed, we also have openings for new members during the evening shifts.

Adult members have the choice of becoming a regular member who commits to one 12 hour shift per week, or an associate member who commits to one 6 hour shift per week.

Youth members commit to one night per week from 6:00 pm until no later than 11:00 pm.
